PIERCING THE CLOUDS WITH PRAYER FROM THE HEART



The prayer that pierces the clouds, that goes most directly to God, and yields quickest powerful results, is the "right prayer of desire" — not the prayer of complaint, and not the prayer for luxury — certainly — (nothing from lust): but the prayer of right true desire — because it is prayer right from the heart.

Right and true mean in accordance with His Plan for your life. The right way. The direct path, even in crisis.

The devil grants extravagance

(and wears Prada).

The Lord gives what you need; he wastes nothing. This is worth repeating: God gives you what you need; the devil gives you luxury.

The Lord may well answer a complaint. He hears all cries. But they have to be sincere ones — which means *real* need; which means it is in accordance with His Plan for you. With God, there is no desperation.

Do you collect yourself as to how you should approach Him? Do you pray about what you should pray about? Do you pray about your mission?

And before you pray, do you set your heart right?

Now, this doesn't mean you can't ask for some nice things. God is very generous. No one is more so! He always outdoes us. He wants us to enjoy life.

But "right" means to pray with measure. It means to pray unselfishly. It means to avoid greed.

It is to ask in a way that is contrite and humble.

"Right" means to have balance and peace and springs from love. You will know when you glow.

There is a map for your life and mission and God is always ready to supply what we need to find our way on it — to negotiate the byways, the detours, the fast lanes on those highways; to avoid the ruts.

The great signpost on the journey of your life is joy, even in trying times.

When there is joy, God is near. It is how to "read the map" that leads to your destiny.

Happiness is great. We can be excited or happy for a period of time. But *joy* speaks more of a long-term state of being, of "contentment" as a passive state that's satisfied with all that happens and has gladness and the humor of wisdom in every circumstance even when there's no worldly security and no jolt of adrenaline (as there is when there is a "thrill"). Contentment is joy without complaint and even when not every want has been gratified.

Those who have cast out lust and materialism and fear (which comes from the flesh or the enemy) know this state, which joins peace as the gauge of God's Presence. Seek to be relaxed and restful and at peace in every circumstance.

The devil does not give joy but rather thrills and daring and that flash-in-the-pan excitement that rides a roller-coaster.

Remember that thrills can kill and that the daredevil's "joy" is counterfeit (and that

roller-coasters are short rides to nowhere).

True joy comes when we cast *out* the devil in the Name of Jesus!

"Dear children, today I wish to call you to pray, pray, pray," said a message in 1985 from Medjugorje. "In prayer you shall perceive the greatest joy, and the way out of every situation that has no exit."

In fact, *only* through prayer — not politics, not business, not science — will we take the right course in life, the right actions. This is also true in our lives: prayer offers surprising answers. When we're confronted with what seems impossible, we pray and with sudden clarity see the way out. You know how it is: Often we find ourselves in what seems like a bleak place. Often we can't imagine *how* to solve a problem. Often we find ourselves in situations that seem to have no good alternative.

It could be a financial crisis. It could be a problem with one's career. It could be a dilemma with children. It could be a pandemic.

From time to time we all feel painted into a corner.

That's the time to pray. That's the time to drop everything and lift the heart upward. It's remarkable how solutions wing into our heads during prayer — answers that would otherwise allude us.

Here's something that can change your life, or at least your attitude. It's a simple message: with the eyes of faith, we become victors and not victims and fulfill who we really are. That's quite a promise. No matter where you are, no matter how life has been treating you, there is always the opportunity to pull ourselves up by the bootstraps and turn what seems like a situation without an exit into victory.

Joy is hope. Joy is to be fulfilled. Joy is when the cup of your life mission is filling up. Joy is knowing where you are on the "map."

Always choose joy over short-term "excitement," "contentment," or "happiness"! It comes, does true joy, when you ask for it in the *right* way and your request comes from a heart that loves.

OUR LADY OF MEDJUGORJE, QUEEN OF PEACE

Dear Family of Mary!

Today we pray for all souls who are lukewarm. These are souls who barely care about God and who live their lives in a forgetful fog. They do not know where they are going or why, because they do not recognize God as God, and do not desire Him. They are indifferent to everything spiritual. We could say that our materialistic, hedonistic cultures create such souls, by distracting them from their true destiny, and convincing them that this life is all that matters.

Our Lady spoke about such souls in this message:



November 20, 1986 "Dear children! Today also I am calling you to live and follow with a special love all the messages which I am giving you. Dear children, God does not want you lukewarm and undecided, but that you totally surrender to Him. You know that I love you and that out of love I long for you. Therefore, dear children, you also decide for love so that you will long for and daily experience God's love. Dear children, decide for love so that love prevails in all of you, but not human love, rather God's love. Thank you for having responded to my call."

Our Lady offers a way to heal our indifferent and lukewarm hearts in this message. Her messages are a helping hand into the real world of faith and love. She is with us to guide us into the true reality of life with God! No more indifference for us!

Jesus spoke to St. Faustina about lukewarm souls as well: 367. + On one occasion, Jesus gave me to know that when I pray for intentions which people are wont to entrust to me, He is always ready to grant His graces, but souls do not always want to accept them: My Heart overflows with great mercy for souls, and especially for poor sinners. If only they could understand that I am the best of Fathers to them and that it is for them that the Blood and Water flowed from My Heart as from a fount overflowing with mercy. For them I dwell in the tabernacle as King of Mercy. I desire to bestow My graces upon souls, but they do not want to accept them. You, at least, come to Me as often as possible and take these graces they do not want to accept. In this way you will console My Heart. Oh, how indifferent are souls to so much goodness, to so many proofs of love! My Heart drinks only of the ingratitude and forgetfulness of souls living in the world. They have time for everything, but they have no time to come to Me for graces.

Indifference and lukewarm faith are rampant in our time. This last day is a plea for prayer for countless souls who have no idea what road they are on. To be lukewarm is to deny the future, to deny eternal life and the reality of Heaven and Hell. To be lukewarm is worse than being dead. As Jesus said in scripture:

"`I know your works: you are neither cold nor hot. Would that you were cold or hot! So, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of my mouth. For you say, I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing; not knowing that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked. Therefore I counsel you to buy from me gold refined by fire, that you may be rich, and white garments to clothe you and to keep the shame of your nakedness from being seen, and salve to anoint your eyes, that you may see. Those whom I love, I reprove and chasten; so be zealous and repent. (Rev 3:15-19)

Divine Mercy is the source of all those things we lack - gold, garments, and salve. Divine

Mercy can make up for all we lack in holiness and fervor for the Lord. We need to turn to God's mercy and surrender completely to Him now, before it is too late.
