**ПАПА ФРАНЦИСК ЗАКЛИКАВ НЕ ПРИПИНЯТИ
МОЛИТИСЯ ЗА МИР В УКРАЇНІ**

Зустрічаючись із паломниками на традиційній середовій аудієнції, Папа Франциск подякував тим, які два тижні тому особливо молилися за мир в Україні, і побажав успішного результату дипломатичним зусиллям, а також закликав молитися за хворих.



Два тижні тому, 26 січня 2022 року, світ єднався в молитві за мир, відповівши на заклик Папи Франциска, який проголосив спеціальний день молитви, пов'язаний із зростанням напруження навколо кордонів України. Святіший Отець особисто того дня очолив таку молитву наприкінці загальної аудієнції.

А завершуючи зустріч з прочанами в середу, 9 лютого, він склав подяку всім, хто відгукнувся на його заклик.

«Хочу подякувати всім людям і спільнотам, які 26 січня єдналися в молитві за мир в Україні. Не переставаймо випрошувати в Бога миру, аби напруження та загроза війни були подолані шляхом серйозного діалогу, і щоб що цього змогли причинитися також і переговори у Нормандському форматі. Не забуваймо: війна – це безумство!» – наголосив Святіший Отець.

Папа також нагадав, що 11 лютого відзначатиметься Всесвітній день хворого. «Хочу згадати всіх наших дорогих хворих і побажати, щоб усім були забезпечені медичне лікування та духовний супровід», — сказав він, закликавши молитися за хворих, їхніх родичів, медичних працівників, капеланів і всіх, хто опікується хворими.

Solitude Makes Real Fellowship Possible

By slowly converting our loneliness into a deep solitude, we create that precious space where we can discover the voice telling us about our inner necessity—that is, our vocation. Unless our questions, problems, and concerns are tested and matured in solitude, it is not realistic to expect answers that are really our own. . . . This is a very difficult task, because in our world we are constantly pulled away from our innermost self and encouraged to look for answers instead of listening to the questions. A lonely person has no inner time or inner rest to wait and listen. He wants answers and wants them here and now. But in solitude we can pay attention to the inner self. This has nothing to do with egocentrism or unhealthy introspection because in the words of [Rainer Maria] Rilke, “what is going on in your innermost being is worthy of your whole love.” In solitude we can become present to ourselves. There we also can become present to others by reaching out to them, not greedy for attention and affection but offering our own selves to help build a community of love. Solitude does not pull us away from our fellow human beings but instead makes real fellowship possible.

THEME OF POPE’S GENERAL AUDIENCE: ‘ST. JOSEPH, PATRON OF THE GOOD DEATH’

At his February 2 general audience—the eleventh in a series of Wednesday audiences on St. Joseph—Pope Francis reflected on St. Joseph as the patron of a happy death. Previous audiences were devoted to [St. Joseph and the environment in which he lived](#) (November 17), [St. Joseph and salvation history](#) (November 24), [St. Joseph, just man and husband of Mary](#) (December 1), and [St. Joseph, man of silence](#) (December 15), [St. Joseph, persecuted and courageous migrant](#) (December 29), [St. Joseph, Jesus’ foster father](#) (January 5), [St. Joseph the Carpenter](#) (January 12), [St. Joseph, father in tenderness](#) (January 19), [St. Joseph, a man who ‘dreams’](#) (January 26), and [St. Joseph and the communion of saints](#) (February 2).

“In our continuing catechesis on Saint Joseph, we now consider him as the patron of a happy death,” Pope Francis said to pilgrims assembled in Paul VI Audience Hall, according to the official Vatican summary of his remarks. “This traditional devotion was born of the Church’s meditation on Joseph’s own death, comforted by the presence of the Blessed Mother and the Lord Jesus.”

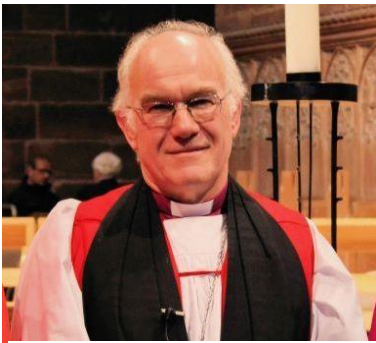
The summary continued:

Today we tend to avoid the thought of our own death, yet our faith in the Risen Jesus invites us not only to be unafraid of death, but to accept it with trust in Christ’s promis-

es. In faith, we see death as a part of life and in turn see life itself in a different perspective. Since we will carry nothing with us to the grave, our concern should be to live lives of faith, hope and charity towards all.

The Church has always shown particular concern for the dying, offering them accompaniment and care, respecting the sacredness of life, even in its final stages, and rejecting the ethically unacceptable practices of euthanasia or assisted suicide. Through the prayers of Saint Joseph and the Virgin Mary, may the hour of our own death be a blessed encounter with God's infinite mercy. For that intention, and for all the dying and those who grieve the loss of their loved ones, we joined earlier in praying the "Hail Mary".

FOURTH ANGLICAN BISHOP IN YEAR JOINS CATHOLIC CHURCH



The former Anglican bishop of Chester, England, has joined the Catholic Church. Peter Forster, 71, is the fourth Anglican bishop to be received into the Catholic faith in less than a year and the fifth to become a Catholic in the past two years.

He served as bishop of Chester for 22 years until his retirement in 2019 and was received into the Catholic Church in the Archdiocese of St. Andrews and Edinburgh, Scotland, where he now lives with his wife, Elizabeth. The private ceremony was understood to have taken place late last year, but Forster did not

wish to make his move public.

THE SECRET KEY OF MEETING WITH GOD!

Dear Family of Mary!

And he said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a lonely place, and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat. And they went away in the boat to a lonely place by themselves. (Mark 6: 31-32)

Jesus had been teaching and healing the multitudes, and he could see that the disciples were exhausted. So he took them in a boat, hoping to find a quiet place to be with them, resting and speaking together. This scripture is a nice representation of what prayer can be for us. Jesus wants to take us off by ourselves for a while, where we each can rest with Him

and speak to Him.

Such a time of rest and conversation is very healing and restoring. It is such a human need. But in our modern times we are tempted to use the internet, the TV, and other media to take the place of quiet and conversation. We are so occupied that we don't realize how lonely and tired we are.

Our Lady calls us to prayer. It is a kind of prayer in which we can go to a lonely place and speak with Jesus. It is the kind of prayer in which nothing matters but our relationship with the Lord. He is with us and we speak together about so many things. It is a time to rest our souls with our Lord.

Our Lady wants this for us. She has spoken about having a "meeting" with God several times. Here are three messages in which she encourages us to go off alone with Jesus and speak to Him:

November 25, 1988 "Dear children! I call you to prayer, to have an encounter with God in prayer. God gives Himself to you, but He wants you to answer in your own freedom to his invitation. That is why little children during the day, find yourself a special time when you could pray in peace and humility, and have this meeting with God the creator. I am with you and I intercede for you in front of God, so watch in vigil, so that every encounter in prayer be the joy of your contact with God. Thank you for having responded to my call."

March 25, 2008 "Dear children! I call you to work on your personal conversion. You are still far from meeting with God in your heart. Therefore, spend all the more time in prayer and Adoration of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar, for Him to change you and to put into your hearts a living faith and a desire for eternal life. Everything is passing, little children, only God is not passing. I am with you and I encourage you with love. Thank you for having responded to my call."

August 25, 2017 "Dear children! Today I am calling you to be people of prayer. Pray until prayer becomes a joy for you and a meeting with the Most High. He will transform your hearts and you will become people of love and peace. Do not forget, little children, that Satan is strong and wants to draw you away from prayer. You, do not forget that prayer is the secret key of meeting with God. That is why I am with you to lead you. Do not give up on prayer. Thank you for having responded to my call."

May we find our way to that lonely and secret place of prayer, where we can meet our Savior!!
