ПЕРЕХІД УГКЦ В УКРАЇНІ НА НОВИЙ СТИЛЬ ДЛЯ НЕРУХО-МИХ СВЯТ

3 1го вересня 2023 року, з початком нового літургійного року, Українська Греко-Католицька Церква в Україні переходить на новий стиль для нерухомих свят із збереженням чинної Пасхалії.

Таке рішення ухвалив Архиєрейський Синод УГКЦ в Україні на 93-й сесії, що відбулася у Львові-Брюховичах 1–2 лютого 2023 року.

«Взявши до уваги численні прохання віруючих та провівши попередні консультації із духовенством та монашеством нашої Церкви про назрілу потребу реформи Літургійного календаря УГКЦ в Україні, а також зважаючи на душпастирські рації: УГКЦ в Україні перейти з 1 вересня за новим стилем (початок Індикту) 2023 року Божого на новий стиль

для нерухомих свят із збереженням чинної Пасхалії», — йдеться у 1-му пункті 5-ї постанови Синоду.

Відповідно до цього рішення, вже з 1 вересня цього року всі нерухомі свята УГКЦ в Україні святкуватиме за новим стилем. Зокрема, Різдво Христове — 25 грудня, Богоявлення — 6 січня, Благовіщення Пресвятої Богородиці — 25 березня, Покров Пресвятої Богородиці — 1 жовтня, Святого Миколая — 6 грудня тощо.

Парафії, які ще не готові до такого кроку, матимуть можливість із дозволу свого єпископа до вересня 2025 року святкувати нерухомі свята за старим стилем (Різдво Христове — 7 січня, Богоявлення — 19 січня, Благовіщення — 7 квітня тощо). «Для тих парафій чи поодиноких громад, які відчувають себе ще не готовими до такого кроку (за окремим благословенням єпархіального єпископа), залишити можливість літургійного життя за юліанським календарем на період до 2025 року Божого», — йдеться у 2-му пункті 5-ї постанови.

MERCY, EVEN AS WORLD IS AT WAR

"Today, as the world is increasingly tried by wars and straying from God, we need the Mercy of the Father even more."

Pope Francis made that appeal for peace on Wednesday as he spoke to pilgrims gathered in St. Peter's Square for the weekly General Audience.

In his greetings to Polish-speaking pilgrims, the Pope recalled the upcoming celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Solemnity of Divine Mercy was instituted by St. John Paul II "as desired by the Lord Jesus and expressed through St. Faustina Kowalska nearly a century ago."

Pope Francis continued his prayer for the world by quoting the prayer from the Divine Mercy chaplet: "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world."

Near the end of the audience, he added that the Lord "never ceases to be merciful." "Let us think about the mercy of God, which always welcomes and accompanies us, and never leaves us on our own," he said.

Pope Francis also recalled the 60th anniversary of Pope St. John XXIII's 1963 encyclical *Pacem in Terris*, which bore the subtitle "On establishing universal peace in truth, justice, charity, and liberty".

He noted that the landmark encyclical dedicated to peace was written at the height of tensions during the Cold War.

John XXIII, said Pope Francis, opened up for everyone the possibility to speak about peace and laid out the parameters for building peace between peoples.

"His encyclical was a true blessing for humanity, like a ray of light in the midst of dark clouds," he said. "His message remains relevant today."

The Pope quoted paragraph 114 of *Pacem in Terris* to renew his appeal for international relations based on reason instead of strength of arms.

"Relations between States, as between individuals, must be regulated not by armed force, but in accordance with the principles of right reason: the principles, that is, of truth, justice and vigorous and sincere co-operation."

He encouraged everyone to read the encyclical, and urged politicians to draw inspiration from it as they make policy decisions.

Prayers for Ukraine

Finally, Pope Francis recalled his oft-repeated appeal for everyone to pray for Ukraine as the European nation suffers due to Russia's invasion.

"Let us persevere in prayer for the martyred Ukraine," he said. "Let us pray to ease the great suffering of Ukraine."

THIS SUNDAY IS THE FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY!

Every year, the Sunday after Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast day, which will be on April 16th this year, was established by St. John Paul II in 2000, when he canonized St. Faustina — it may be no coincidence that St. John Paul II also passed away on Divine Mercy Sunday in 2005. This feast is a time for the Church to increase its devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, contemplate God's mercy, and grow in forgiveness.

The message that St Faustina received from Christ is central to this feast day: "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet" (St. Faustina's Diary, 699).

As you bring the Feast of Divine Mercy to your prayer, here are five saint quotes that teach us about the infinite mercy of God.

Five Quotes from Catholic Saints About Divine Mercy

- "He who knows how to forgive prepares for himself many graces from God. As often as I look upon the cross, so often will I forgive with all my heart." St. Faustina
- "Those who sincerely say 'Jesus, I trust in You' will find comfort in all their anxieties and fears. There is nothing that man needs more than Divine Mercy – that love which is benevolent, which is compassionate, which raises man above his weakness to the infinite heights of the holiness of God." — St. John Paul I
- "Father of mercy and God of all consolation, graciously look upon me and impart to me
 the blessing which flows from this holy Sacrament. Overshadow me with Your loving
 kindness, and let this divine Mystery bear fruit in me." St. Blaise
- "Do not let the past disturb you, just leave everything in the Sacred Heart and begin again with joy." — Mother Teresa
- "You heard me, only Friend whom I love. To ravish my heart, you became man. You shed your blood, what a supreme mystery!... And you still live for me on the Altar. If I cannot see the brilliance of your Face Or hear your sweet voice, O my God, I can live by your grace, I can rest on your Sacred Heart!" St. Therese of Lisieux

You be those who will convert and, with your life, will witness, love, forgive and bring the joy of the Risen One into this world, where my Son died and where people do not feel a need to seek Him and to discover Him in their lives. October 25, 2011 "Dear children! I am looking at you and in your hearts I do not see joy. Today I desire to give you the joy of the Risen One, that He may lead you and embrace you with His love and tenderness. I love you and I am praying for your conversion without ceasing before my Son Jesus. Thank you for having responded to my call."

April 25, 2018 "Dear children! Today I am calling you to live your new life with Jesus. May the Risen One give you strength to always be strong in the trials of life and to be faithful and persevering in prayer; because Jesus saved you by His wounds and by His Resurrection gave you new life. Pray, little children, and do not lose hope. May joy and peace be in your hearts and witness the joy that you are mine. I am with you and love you all with my motherly love.
